# **JACKSON COUNTY UPDATE**

### Presented by County Executive Mike Sanders

2012 has been another year of progress in Jackson County. A continued point of focus is the need to improve public transit in our region. We are working with our communities throughout the county on a comprehensive



transit plan that would have the ability to connect citizens through a system of trains, buses and trails. Additionally, the county is in the midst of a major renovation project at the Truman Courthouse in Independence. Once complete in 2013, this historic structure will once again be a working courthouse and will help to bring renewed tourism business to our county. Visitors will be able to see Truman's Office and the courtroom where he worked as Presiding Judge of Jackson County. We are able to take on these challenges because of the county's stable financial outlook. We are one of only six counties in the State of Missouri with a "Double A" bond rating. This year, we once again, made the choice to not raise our county tax levy. During our annual independent financial audit this past summer, the county received an unqualified opinion, the highest that can be obtained by any organization, public or private. And each year, our budget remains truly balanced. Just as our citizens must do every day, our county government will continue to live within its means. We are proud to serve our citizens and will always strive to make Jackson County a great place to live, work and raise a family.


