Chamber Through the Decades



The Raytown News headline on July 20, 1950 read: RAYTOWN IS A CITY OF THE FOURTH CLASS AS OF MONDAY, JULY 17, 1950

The Independence Examiner reported on Friday, July 21, 1950 KNOW YOUR COMMUNITY – JACKSON COUNTY'S BABY CITY BLINKS ITS WONDERING EYES

The paper wrote: Raytown, incorporated this week, has capable officials, strong business institutions, thriving churches, modern schools, utilities, a rapidly growing population and all else to make a successful fourth class municipality.

Raytown, Jackson County's baby city, is blinking its eyes at the prospect of the largest and most inviting incorporated area in the county, outside Kansas City. Acting on a petition signed by more than 80% of the property owners in the district, the County Court last Monday granted permission to incorporate as a fourth class city.

The unincorporated area is about I ½ miles square with a population of approximately 1000 persons. For miles beyond its boundaries, however, in all directions are hundreds more homes, which some day may be taken or may petition to be brought in the corporate limits. Here is a densely populated area expanding and building up more rapidly that any district east and south of Kansas City. Leroy Cox, a sturdy, congenial and civic-minded garage operator who was named by the County Court to serve as mayor of the new city until a general election is held the next April.

The Chamber continues to be a staple within the community and looks forward to heling newly incorporated Raytown prepare for the next step.
