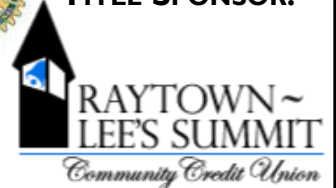

Chamber Through the Decades



On March 3, 1946 Charles W. Graham with the KC Star wrote an article about Raytown. It was titled: Raytown: Lively As A City Without Being One. In it he wrote: “Once the highways came, Raytowners built a score or more of businesses where the buildings formed a T-shaped section at “The Corner” of Raytown Road and 63rd Street. It is a modern suburban community where people own a home and where nearly every child owns a dog. Nowadays to belong means to belong to the Chamber without regard to political principles, church denomination or ancestry.” At the time, the Raytown Chamber was the largest in any unincorporated community.

What struck me most about this part of his article, is Raytown has always embraced their citizens no matter the political principles, church denomination or ancestry. Because of its location it has always seemed to be a welcoming community.

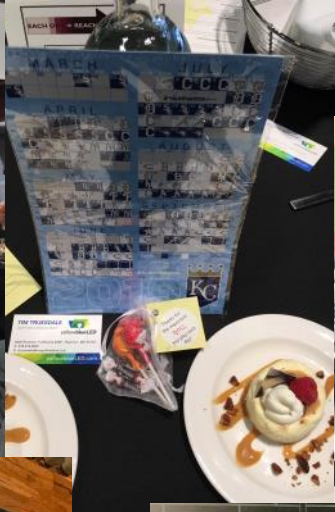

An average day of street sweeping around Raytown should result in 15 miles of curbing swept, 792,000 square feet of street surface swept, and 49,887 pounds of debris removed from streets.
