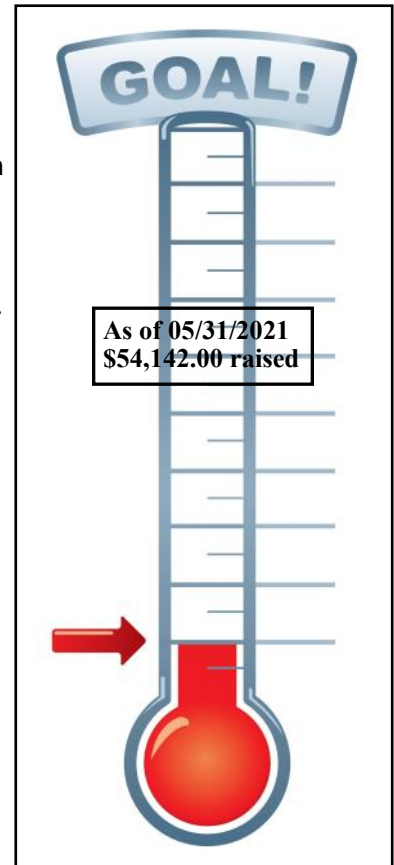
Building Capital Campaign Update & Rock Island Trail Photos

Raytown City Administrator Damon Hodges Recognized in local paper for Father's Day

Cover story highlights black fathers active in the community

In a recent issue of *The Call* newspaper, Raytown City Administrator Damon Hodges was chosen by managing editor Eric Wesson as one of seven men who exemplify fatherhood. The article salutes men in a Father's Day tribute.

"We highlight the men shown in the photos, who range from retired to a city administrator and pastors as well as a financial planner, as a small example of black men who we know are personally active in their child's life or giving back to other children in the community by either example or hands on personally mentoring youth," the article reads.

Hodges was appointed City Administrator in 2018 and was previously Raytown's Public Works Director. Prior to Raytown, he served 15 years at the City of Kansas City, Missouri. He is active in his church, Palestine Missionary Baptist Church, and was a youth sports coach for nearly 10 years. Hodges has been married for more than 20 years and has three children, all of whom he supports by attending their various games, practices, and other activities.



On Thursday June 17th the Raytown Parks Dept hosted the Kid's Day at Kenagy event with a petting zoo, and cooperation with the Raytown Fire Dept, Ambulance and Police. The Connection Point Church volunteered at the event bringing games for the kids, ice and bottled water, and helped set up the area in preparations for the crowd.

Although temperatures were forecast to be near 100* on Thursday, we had a great crowd and the cloud cover kept temperatures down to a reasonable level. Fox 4 news came out to highlight our event that morning and helped notify some of those who hadn't heard of the event.

We want to thank all of those involved in Kid's Day at Kenagy for supporting the community and making a difference to the children and parents in Raytown!

RAYTOWN ROTARY & KITWE NORTH, ZAMBIA, ROTARY CLUB WORK TOGETHER

Raytown Rotary and Kitwe North Rotary Club partnered on a global grant to provide 15 boreholes in four communities outside Kitwe, Zambia. (The award was in the amount of \$40,001.00.) Over 15,000 residents of the Copper Belt region of Zambia are benefitting from this project. This was the first Rotary Global Grant Raytown Rotary ever participated in.

The project is providing clean water and sanitation to 4 rural communities. Collectively, these settlements have a population of approximately 15,000. Provision of clean water was nonexistent. They relied on shallow wells which were prone to waterborne diseases.

This project addresses 2 major community needs:

- Provision of clean water and sanitation.
- Prevention of waterborne diseases.

It is doing so by trying to meet these 3 goals:

- Facilitating universal and equitable access to safe and affordable drinking water.
- Improving water quality by protecting and maintaining surface- and groundwater resources, reducing pollution and contaminants, and promoting wastewater reuse.
- Improving community hygiene knowledge, behaviors, and practices that help prevent the spread of disease.

Budget items, including equipment and labor, were purchased from local vendors in Zambia. Now that the project is completed, each community owns the equipment through their Community Development Committee. Local funding sources have been found to sustain project outcomes for the long term. The project has been completed, and over 15,000 residents of the Copper Belt region of Zambia are benefitting from this project.

350 Highway Construction Updates

CONSTRUCTION ALERT!

Raytown Road at Intersection of Missouri 350 to close

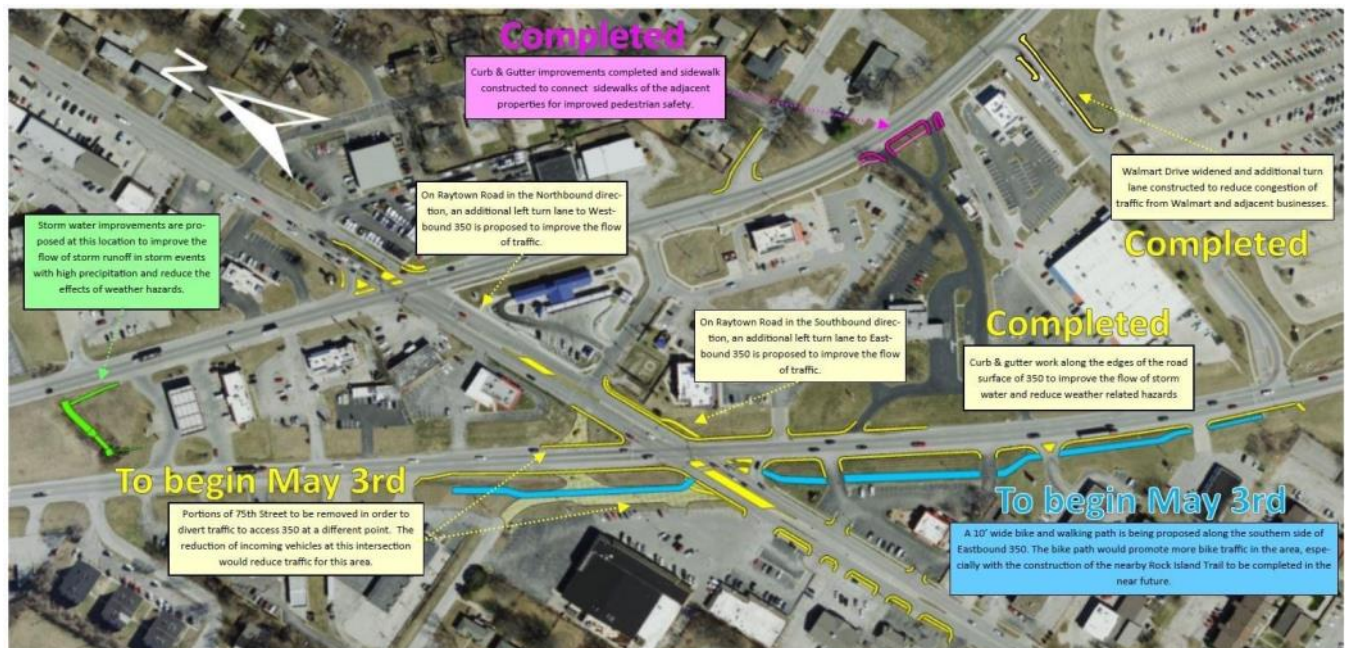
Starting July 6th, Raytown Road will be closed eastbound and westbound at Missouri 350 as crews work on overhead traffic signals. At the intersection of Missouri 350 and Raytown Road both northbound and southbound traffic must turn right.

The detour for northbound Raytown Road is to turn left onto Walmart Drive and then left again onto Missouri 350 westbound. To detour southbound on Raytown Road, turn right onto Gregory Boulevard, then left onto Missouri 350 eastbound.

The project should be completed in about four weeks, weather dependent. There could be a lane reduction on Missouri 350 between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. nightly.

Motorists can expect delays and are advised to allow extra time, reduce speed, be alert to equipment and workers, and use caution when traveling through this area.
