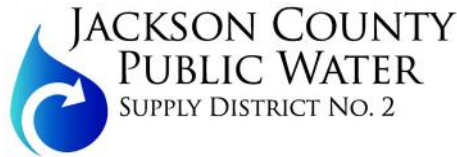

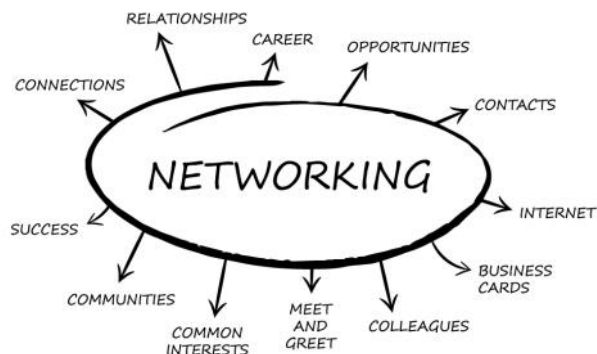

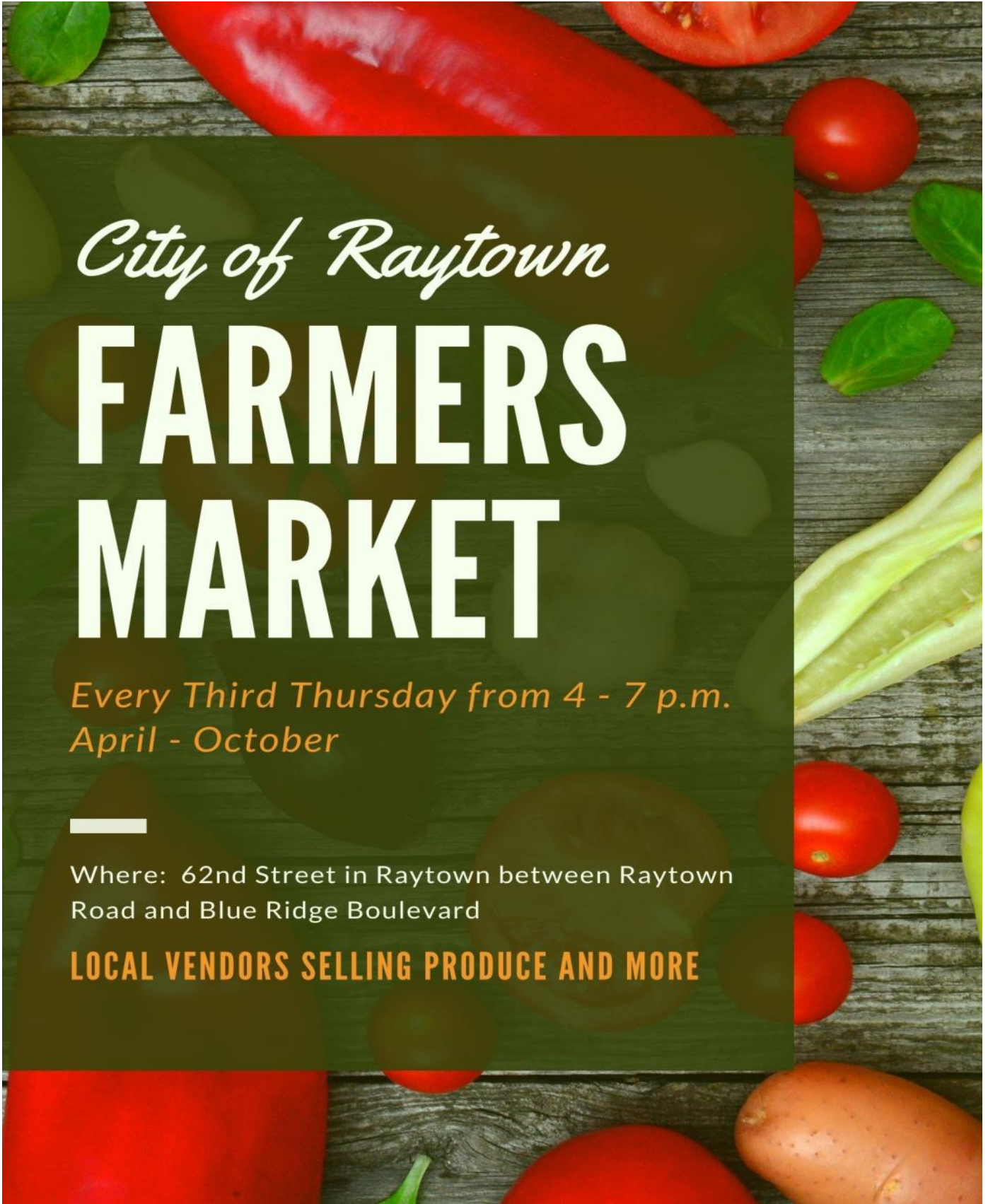

FROM THE DESK OF
MAYOR MIKE MCDONOUGH
City of Raytown, Mo

To my fellow citizens of Raytown, Missouri,

On August 2nd, 2022, we have on the ballot for Raytown voters, Questions 1, 2 and 3. Questions 1 and 2 deal specifically with the infrastructure that is in dire need of improvement.

Question 1 will take care of our storm drainage system problems that this city has had for many years. I can remember as a kid, my parents and others complaining about the storm sewers and the backups and damage to property and roads. The bonds from question one will fix those problems now, rather than sometime in the next 40 years.

Question 2 will help take care of our roads. They have deteriorated to the point that over 40 % of our roads in Raytown are in poor condition and cannot be repaired with a bandage approach. It has taken decades for the roads to get into this condition, and we need to start over from scratch in getting them fixed. In other words, we need to dig them out to the dirt and start over anew.

Question 3 will be a \$.30 cent increase to the mill levy for the City of Raytown. This city levy has not changed since 1978. This money will help fund the maintenance of the roads that are still fixable, for general operations of this city and its vital services. Do you want improved services? It costs money. Try running your businesses or households on a budget from 1978. It doesn't work well.

I know times are tough right now, but they will get better. They always have. We cannot afford to wait. The cost of construction is going up and will continue to do so. It took over two years to put this together, using expertise and forethought from many sources, to present to you the voters, and to get the "best bang for your buck." We will continue to seek out federal funds to help with projects too. Federal dollars are your money too and we would like to have it here to work for you.

I am asking you to please vote yes on all three questions and help us make this city better now and in the future. Let's be one Raytown.
