

# FULL EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL LOOKING FOR INTERNSHIP WORKSITES

Full Employment Council would like to offer your organization the opportunity to be an internship worksite for young adults between the ages of 16-24. This youth work experience is for residents of Cass, Clay, Platte, Ray, and Jackson counties, who meet eligibility requirements. FEC will be the employer of record and will pay \$15.00 an hour to the intern. The maximum number of hours an intern can work is 267 hours, and the schedule can be determined by you. For example, a work schedule can be 4 hours per day or 8 hours per day not to exceed 40hrs per week. Internships must be completed by June 30, 2023.

Examples of activities that youth can do within your organization include customer services, information technology, finance and accounting, recruitment, etc.... Those youth who enroll and have their High School Diploma or HiSet may qualify for a tuition award to attend Community College or a Vocational training institution in a training that leads to a certification.

# Caffeine Hunters Will Have Another Option in Raytown Dutch Bros Coffee breaks ground on Raytown drive-thru this week

In March, construction commenced for a Dutch Bros Coffee location between Freddy's Frozen Custard & Steakburgers and IHOP on Highway 350 in Raytown. Dutch Bros Coffee is a drive-thru coffee company dedicated to making a massive difference one cup at a time. Headquartered in Grants Pass, Oregon, where it was founded in 1992, it's now sharing the "Dutch Luv" with more than 700 locations in 14 states.

"We're so excited to be part of the Raytown community," said Katie Henell, operator of Dutch Bros Raytown. "We can't wait to meet all of our new neighbors later this year!"

The \$400,000 drive-thru facility located at 10025 E. 350 Highway will include two-lane drive thrus and a walk-up window. The new 950 square foot facility will be constructed by BEAR Construction Services LLC of Overland Park, Kansas. This location is expected to open this fall.

# Members in the News - From the Earth



### **CANNABIS IN THE WILD (MID)WEST**

By David Craig From The Earth and Illicit VP of Marketing

Missouri's recreational launch is the talk of the cannabis industry, with the state's first month of legal sales placing it 3<sup>rd</sup> highest of the 21 Rec launches to date, only behind California and Arizona. We anticipate Missouri to be one of the top 8 largest cannabis markets nationwide by 2030, with some projecting 2024 total sales will reach \$2 billion. The biggest question we're being asked is how did we prepare and how are we planning on moving forward?

From the moment we knew the Amendment was going to be on the midterm ballot, we created a long-term plan to get our dispensaries ready for the launch. That meant renovating all locations to add more checkout stations, improve customer and back-of-house flows, and streamline check-in processes. Each of our 5 locations has between 10 and 14 checkout stations, which allows us to shorten wait times dramatically. We've held multiple job fairs to fill open positions and have hired over 100+ staff members to our dispensary teams.

Our average customer count increased as many as 14+ times in some locations for the first few weeks of Rec sales. While counts are still high, they have come down significantly now and things are starting to settle into a more consistent rhythm. Wait times are down and the experience is much smoother.

We have been working together with suppliers to secure future inventory and overcome product shortages. The end of those shortages is right around the corner, and here is why: cannabis takes time to grow, cure, trim, packaged, and ship. For manufactured goods, the timeframe is longer. The window between seed to sale is longer than time between the November 8<sup>th</sup> midterm election and the February 3<sup>rd</sup> Rec launch. What that means is current shortages are already on their way to being over as future products are already being grown. For those cultivation facilities that have not built to the maximum legal canopy capacity, that expansion is already underway.

By securing products from this new, expanded wave of production, we will be able to supply a continuous and diverse stream of products to both Med and Rec customers. While we anticipated inventory to become moderately restricted for the first 60 to 90 days, while cultivation and manufacturing facilities recalibrated based on incoming data on Rec demand, everyone was caught off guard by the sheer number of customers we've received. All producers we've spoken too are in the process of maximizing output across the board to keep up, and we're confident that by mid-spring the state will be meeting all demand.

In the next 30 days if you're standing in a line that's taking longer than you'd like, or if you're not able to find a specific product you're hunting for, know that this is normal for the first 90 days of a medical market transitioning to a recreational one. The people working in that store want you to leave happy and are doing everything in their power to ensure you have a positive experience. Be patient, be understanding, and we'll be through this transitional phase in no time. We're grateful to everyone who supports the cannabis industry and we're looking to a bright future for Missouri.
